Submission Guidelines

- 1. Entrants must be residents of South Australia.
- 2. All entries must be original and written in English.
- 3. Entry is free with a Maximum of two (2) entries per person.
- 4. A submission form must accompany each submission. These can be downloaded from Facebook PBA-FM Community Radio or picked up at the PBA FM premises in Salisbury.
- 5. Your name, details, email and poem title(s) are required on the submission form.
- 6. No poems previously submitted for the first *Well Versed* are eligible for *Well Versed 2*.
- 7. Name each poem's file in the 'Surname My Poem' ie 'Smith My Cat' if you are entering by email include your poem(s) and submission form as attachments.
- 8. Emailed entries should be in simple, clear formatting (12pt Arial or Times New Roman font, double spaced, wide margins and left justified) and submitted in either PDF or word format.
- 9. Submission by email is to **competitions@pbafm.org.au**. Please put '**Well Versed 2**' in the subject line.
- Paper submissions can be dropped in to PBA FM, 17-19 Wiltshire Street, Salisbury.
 Entries must be in clear simple formatting if word processed, or in clear, legible handwriting.
- 11. Copying of poems submitted are the responsibility of the author, please ensure you keep a copy of your entry as it will not be returned.
- 12. Poems are to be no longer than 60 lines.
- 13. No props apart from voice are to be included in recordings.
- 14. Poems can be recorded in a language other than English, accompanied with a translation of the poem in spoken English as well.
- 15. Recording for Well Versed 2 will be made at the PBA FM Recording Studio, Salisbury only.
- 16. Entries which infringe on the intellectual property rights of any third party, contain profanity or potentially insulting, inflammatory or defamatory language, will be ineligible.
- 17. This agreement gives PBA FM the right to record and broadcast the submitted poems, and to make an audio book collection of the *Well Versed 2* Program, all other copyright of individual poems will remain with the author.
- 18. Completed entries must be lodged by 5pm ACST 31 October 2019. Late applications will not be considered.
