Ted Leigh does Wednesday Morning music from 9-11am and then follows that up with Midweek Jazz and Swing from 11am – 12.30pm. Here's what he has to say about those programs.

I was a PBA-FM listener when I was still at work that was about 30 years ago. 22 years ago during senior's week I went to the studio at Smith Road, went through training and have been on air since then. I am not a musician, but always liked music, mainly of my era I must confess and I have had many listeners ring to say they like what they hear. These days I am on air on Wednesday mornings from 9 until 12.30 I structure the items based on birthdays during the week, including well known people not necessarily singers or instrumentalists. So from 9 until 11 I cover from the 30s to the 80s, the same for Midweek Jazz and Swing, I also have a segment I call Miller Moments. From the feedback I have had over the 22 years as I said earlier there is an audience for this type of program. I am in the upper age bracket of course getting a bit slower, but hope to carry on for some time yet.
